we define the essential skills to be a set of simple procedural skills that 1 must be applied frequently for success in coursework and 2 are largely automated in experts such skills can be found in almost any introductory science course including physics engineering chemistry and mathematics students often lack the necessary fluency with the essential skills making them less likely to succeed in the course this thesis proposes an iterative and systematic essential skills framework by which student difficulties with the essential skills in any course may be identified and addressed the essential skills framework consists of five stages 1 identifying essential skills for a given domain or course 2 identifying and characterizing common student difficulties with the essential skills 3 designing and testing training to improve student fluency with the essential skills 4 implementing distributed mastery graded computer based training with the essential skills as a graded course component and 5 iteratively testing and improving the effectiveness of the training each stage is discussed providing recommendations from the research literature and the author's own research implementations of the essential skills framework in two courses at the ohio state university have achieved gains as high as 1.5 standard deviations even more powerful is that these gains resulted from only 90 minutes median training time over the course of the whole term in addition to improving student fluency with the essential skills the essential skills framework also improved student self efficacy a key predictor of student success in science courses
